



## Hungarian Noodles


Yield: 10 servings

### Ingredients:

- 16 ounces wide egg noodles
- 3 cubes chicken bouillon
- $\frac{1}{4}$  cup water
- 10 $\frac{3}{4}$  ounces condensed cream of mushroom soup
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup chopped onion
- 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tablespoon poppy seeds
- $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon garlic powder
- $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon hot pepper sauce
- 2 cups cottage cheese
- 2 cups sour cream
- $\frac{1}{4}$  cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 pinch paprika

### Directions:

- Cook egg noodles according to package directions. Drain well.
- In a large bowl, dissolve chicken bouillon cubes in boiling water. Mix in the cream of mushroom soup, chopped onion, Worcestershire sauce, poppy seeds, garlic powder, and hot pepper sauce. Stir in cottage cheese, sour cream, and cooked egg noodles.
- Transfer to lightly greased slow cooker, and sprinkle the top with Parmesan cheese and paprika. Cover and cook on high for 3 to 4 hours. Serve immediately.




## Hungarian Embroidery

### Materials:


- Colored burlap (available at fabric stores)
- Chalk
- Thin shoelaces (multiple colors)
- Inexpensive embroidery hoops
- Scissors

### Instructions:

1. Insert the burlap into the hoop, removing as much slack as possible.
2. Draw a simple pattern on the burlap.
3. Remove one plastic tip from the shoelace and tie a knot on the end.
4. Using the remaining plastic tip of the shoelace as the needle, begin stitching, following the simple pattern.
5. Use multiple stitches on a line to draw the pattern.
6. When finished (or before switching colors), make a tight knot on the bottom side of the hoop. Snip the end.
7. Note: If the weave of your burlap is too tight, consider yarn for your thread. Use tape to make a "needle" on one end.

### Devotion and Prayers

Read Proverbs 3:1–6.



As we grow up, we learn so many things. Sometimes, learning can be difficult. Other times, we are tempted to think that we already know everything there is to know and that we don't need to learn anything more. Proverbs 3 reminds us that there is much more to wisdom and knowledge than what we study in textbooks. "Do not lean on your own understanding," God tells us (v. 5). "Do not forget My teaching," He reminds.

We know that Jesus, the Word made flesh, is our Savior. We know this because we learn about Him in God's Word, the Bible. Our Lord loves us so much, He wants us to know the most important lesson: Jesus died and rose for us to deliver us from evil. The Holy Spirit helps us to trust in the Lord and to thank Him for His saving Word.

When we forget this or have trouble trusting in God, we can repent. Our loving Father will forgive us for Jesus' sake and will remind us of His steadfast love.
